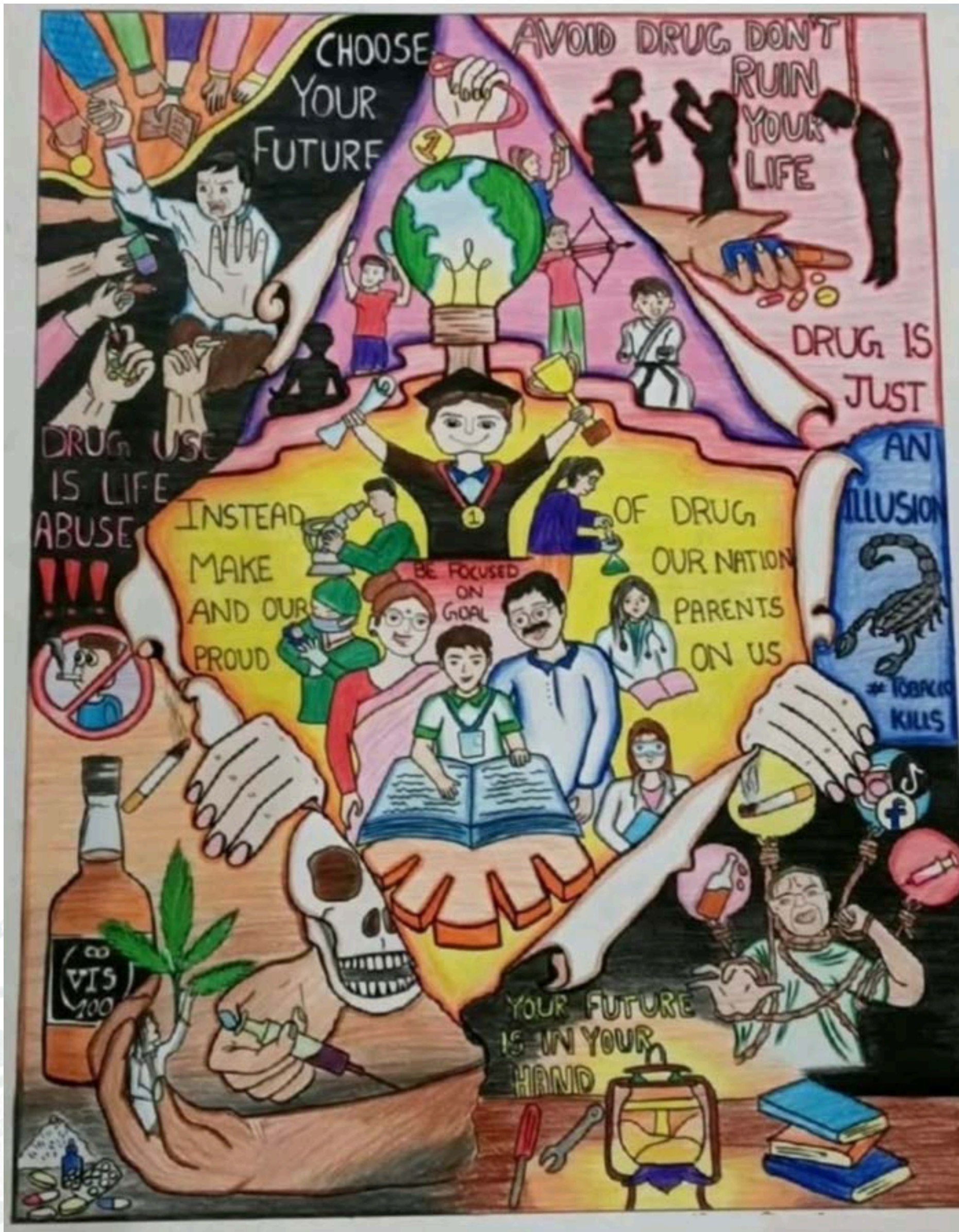

Union Budget 2026–27: A Practical Roadmap for Growth and Stability

Every year, the Union Budget sets the tone for India's economic journey, and the Budget 2026–27, presented on 1st February 2026 by Finance Minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman, is no exception. Beyond numbers and allocations, it reflects the Government's vision for growth, development, and opportunity across sectors. For Chartered Accountancy students and professionals, the Budget is more than a financial statement—it is a guide to understanding policy changes, taxation trends, and the future direction of the economy. Hence, analysing this year's Budget becomes both relevant and meaningful for the CA community.

The Budget lays down a blueprint that balances economic expansion with fiscal prudence and social inclusivity. Total expenditure is estimated at around ₹53.47 lakh crore for FY 2026–27, with a record capital expenditure (capex) of ₹12.21 lakh crore to fuel infrastructure creation and productivity enhancements. This focus on capex—an increase of roughly 9 % from the previous year—signals the Government's intent to strengthen the physical and logistical backbone of the economy. Alongside, the fiscal deficit has been targeted at 4.3 % of GDP, maintaining a path of fiscal consolidation while allowing growth-oriented spending.

For citizens and taxpayers, the Budget offers a mix of relief measures and structural reforms. One of the most discussed changes is the implementation of the New Income Tax Act from April 2026, aimed at simplifying compliance and reducing procedural complexity—a welcome step for individuals and businesses alike. In addition, the Government extended deadlines for revising income tax returns and reduced the Tax Collected at Source (TCS) on overseas education, travel, and medical remittances from as high as 20 % in some cases down to 2 %, easing costs for many taxpayers.

Sector-wise impacts reflect a strategic push toward competitiveness and innovation. The large capex allocation supports transport and connectivity projects including seven new high-speed rail corridors and expansion of national waterways, strengthening logistics links across regions. Manufacturing and technology sectors received attention through initiatives such as India Semiconductor Mission 2.0 and special incentives for cloud infrastructure firms. Support for MSMEs was bolstered with a ₹10,000 crore growth fund, designed to enhance resilience and global competitiveness. These measures, coupled with increased allocations for education, healthcare, and digital transformation, indicate a comprehensive approach to long-term industrial and economic development.

However, a balanced view also requires acknowledgement of areas that could benefit from caution. While the Budget maintains fiscal discipline, the limited direct tax relief for individuals may not translate into immediate consumption boosts—a factor that could temper short-term economic sentiment. Changes such as adjustments in Securities Transaction Tax and market regulations may impact investor behaviour temporarily. Moreover, the translation of ambitious investments into tangible outcomes will depend heavily on the efficiency and timeliness of implementation at both the central and state levels. Sustained progress therefore hinges not only on policy announcements but also on effective execution.
